



**POLICY ON USE OF THE BECKMAN CENTER  
BY  
NON-ACADEMIES GROUPS**

Non-profit organizations that are not affiliated with the Academies may request space at the Beckman Center for activities in the following areas:

- (i) Ethical and social issues affecting the development and application of science, technology and the practice of medicine;
- (ii) The health of the scientific and technological endeavor in the United States, with particular reference to education and the training of men and women for research, and the availability of the necessary tools, including advanced instrumentation;
- (iii) Technology transfer, including transfer from research to commercialization, and the global diffusion and use of advanced technologies;
- (iv) International cooperation in science and technology;
- (v) Teaching, research and other academic functions in any field of science, technology, engineering, mathematics, medicine, or health policy, including the intersection of one or more of these fields with other fields of academic research and intellectual inquiry; or
- (vi) Activities in other areas involving science, technology, mathematics, medicine, or health policy.

The Beckman Center may not be used:

- (i) For any activity sponsored by any organization or individual that practices or advocates discrimination based on race, creed, color, sex, national origin, or sexual orientation;
- (ii) For any activity with a partisan political, sectarian, or similar nature or purpose;
- (iii) For fund raising purposes; or
- (iv) By a for-profit entity or for the promotion of any commercial product or service – including any commercial display and/or distribution of samples, gifts, or items other than product literature – or for any other commercial purpose.

The Beckman Center must be referred to in all material related to the meeting or event as “The [Arnold and Mabel] Beckman Center of the National Academies of Sciences and Engineering.” The Beckman Center must be provided a copy of all written material describing the meeting or event at least two weeks in advance.
