

Robert J. Blake (Ph.D. University of Texas, Austin) is Professor of Spanish at UC Davis and founding Director of the UC Consortium for Language Learning & Teaching (<http://uccllt.ucdavis.edu>). He has published widely in the fields of Spanish linguistics, second language acquisition, and computer-assisted language learning. He was the academic consultant for Nuevos Destinos (Annenberg/CPB Project, WGBH, and McGraw-Hill Companies) and co-author for Tesoros (BeM, McGraw-Hill Companies), a five-disk multimedia CD-ROM program for introductory Spanish. In 2004, he was inducted into the North American Academy for the Spanish Language, making him a corresponding member of the Royal Spanish Academy. Dr. Blake is currently working through the Consortium on two projects to provide distance-learning in Arabic and Punjabi.
