Important travel items:

- The Washington Reagan National Airport is the most convenient airport to the hotel and meeting location. Alternate area airports (Dulles and BWI) can be used but are 40-60 minutes outside of the city.
- If traveling by train, participants will arrive at Union Station (50 Massachusetts Ave NE, Washington, DC). The National Academy of Sciences (NAS) Building is in the Foggy Bottom area of Washington, D.C. Participants can take Metro's Orange, Silver, or Blue Line to the Foggy Bottom-GWU station.
